Hands-On Course In Sinus Lift Augmentation And Dental Implants

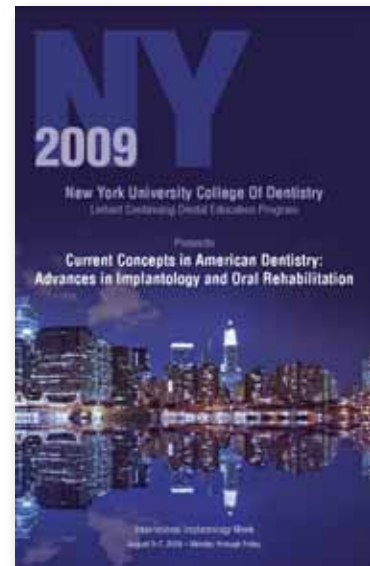

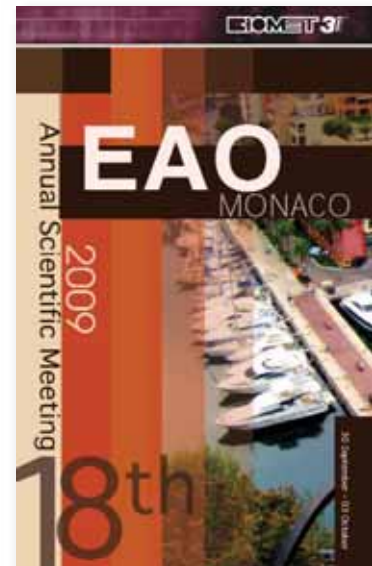
